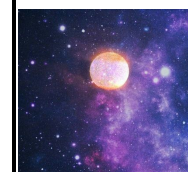

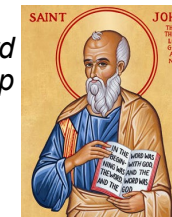

Jesus said: 'I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd is one who lays down his life for his sheep. The hired man, since he is not the shepherd and the sheep do not belong to him, abandons the sheep and runs away as soon as he sees a wolf coming, and then the wolf attacks and scatters the sheep; this is because he is only a hired man and has no concern for the sheep. 'I am the good shepherd; I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I lay down my life for my sheep. And there are other sheep I have that are not of this fold, and these I have to lead as well. They too will listen to my voice, and there will be only one flock, and one shepherd. 'The Father loves me, because I lay down my life in order to take it up again. No one takes it from me; I lay it down of my own free will, and as it is in my power to lay it down, so it is in my power to take it up again; and this is the command I have been given by my Father.'

**1<sup>st</sup> Reading (Acts 4:8-12)**

*The name of Jesus Christ is the only name in which we can be saved*

Filled with the Holy Spirit, Peter said: ‘Rulers of the people, and elders! If you are questioning us today about an act of kindness to a cripple, and asking us how he was healed, then I am glad to tell you all, and would indeed be glad to tell the whole people of Israel, that it was by the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene, the one you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by this name and by no other that this man is able to stand up perfectly healthy, here in your presence, today. This is the stone rejected by you the builders, but which has proved to be the keystone. For of all the names in the world given to men, this is the only one by which we can be saved.’

**ARCHDIOCESAN SCREENING AND MONITORING POLICY:**

The Archdiocesan Screening and Monitoring Policy provides processes to reduce the risk of unsuitable persons being engaged in Church activities or services in order to protect the safety of children, young people and adults at risk. This policy apply to all members of the Church Community. The screening are therefore required for different roles in the parishes within the Catholic Archdiocese of Perth. As a result, the certification of these requirements have to be submitted to the parish office. The roles and the requirements are: (1) **Acolyte** needs to submit WWCC, and Safeguarding personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (2) **Altar Server (adult)** needs to submit WWCC, Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (Continue on next column...)

**ARCHDIOCESAN SCREENING AND MONITORING POLICY (continue):**

(3) **Altar Server (child under 18 years)** needs to submit Parents’ consent. (4) **Audio-visual Technician (adult)** needs to submit Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (5) **Music/Choir Member** needs to submit Safeguarding Personal Declaration and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (6) **Music/Choir Leader Interacting with Children** needs to submit WWCC, Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (7) **Catechist** needs to submit WWCC, Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (8) **Children Helper Under 18 Years** needs to submit Parents’ consent. (9) **Clergy** needs to submit WWCC, National Police Clearance or Volunteer National Police Clearance, Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every year. (10) **Cleaner (paid/unpaid)** needs to submit National Police Clearance or Volunteer National Police Clearance, Safeguarding Personal Declaration and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (11) **Collector** needs to submit Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (12) **Counter** needs to submit Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (13) **Extraordinary Minister** needs to submit WWCC, Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (14) **Flower Arranger (unpaid)** needs to submit Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (15) **Greeter at Mass(adult)** needs to submit Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (16) **Groundsman/Gardner** needs to submit Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (17) **Offertory Procession (adult)** needs to submit Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (18) **Parish Secretary (paid/unpaid)** needs to submit WWCC, National Police Clearance or Volunteer National Police Clearance, Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (19) **Parish Council Member** needs to submit Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (20) **Parish Finance Council Member** needs to submit National Police Clearance or Volunteer National Police Clearance, Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (21) **Photographer/Video Technician** needs to submit WWCC, Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (22) **Prayer Group/Bible Study Leader** needs to submit Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (23) **RCIA Coordinator/Leader (adult only group)** needs to submit Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (24) **Reader of Prayer** needs to submit Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (25) **Reader or Lector (Reader at Mass)** needs to submit Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (26) **Sacramental Program Coordinator/Leader** needs to submit WWCC, Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (27) **Sacristan** needs to submit WWCC, Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. (28) **Volunteer** needs to submit WWCC (if interaction with child/children), Safeguarding Personal Declaration, and attend Safeguarding Induction Training every three years. Please, try as much as possible to submit all these requirements to the parish office if any applies to you.
